# Allstar Surety Bonds 101

### WHO'S WHO

#### THE PRINCIPAL

The construction company or contractor required to post a bond.

#### THE OBLIGEE

Government entity, owner, general contractor or person requiring principal to be bonded.

#### THE SURETY

Provides guarantee to obligee on behalf of principal.

## Surety Bond DEFINED

A surety bond is simply an agreement between three parties: principal, surety and obligee. The surety provides a guarantee to the obligee that the principal will fulfill their obligations.

MANY CITY, STATE, & FEDERAL AGENCIES REQUIRE A BOND TO BID AND PERFORM WORK ON A PROJECT.

## HOW IT WORKS

- The principal promises to perform the work contracted by the obligee.
  - If the construction company fails to meet the agreed upon obligations the obligee can file a claim against the bond that is backed by the surety.
- The surety will assign a new contractor to finish the project or settle the project with a financial sum.
